Increased attendance = happy vendors, and happy vendors = returning vendors, a larger variety of vendors. That makes for a bigger event giving you more choices.

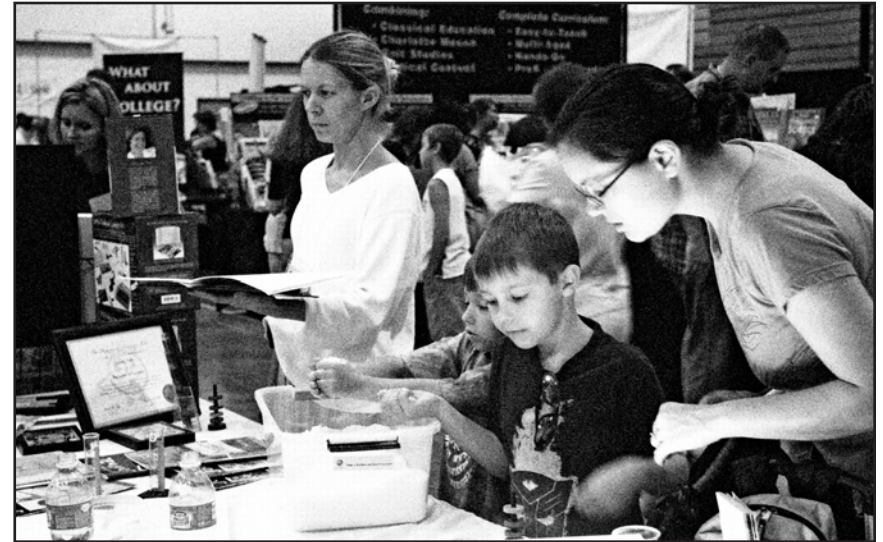
Please consider helping us spread news about the event.

- 1 Plan to be there yourself. Mark your calendar for July 23 and 24.
- 2 Clip or photocopy flier at right and put these in doctors' offices, church bulletin boards, libraries and store notice boards.
- 3 See if you can get the fair/expo in a Sunday bulletin July 4 or 11. Try to get the flier in; if that's too much, suggest a blurb. Talk to the person in charge ahead of time.
- 4 Spread the word, give fliers or make announcements at Bible studies, Sunday school groups, play groups, swim clubs and other clubs, any place in which parents gather.
